WATER-BORNE WOOD STAIN SYSTEM FOR EXTERIOR WOODEN SURFACES

PINJA W-OIL 394 -serie

The water-borne system WW24 is a translucent stain system for exterior wooden claddings, doors, panels, garden furniture, log houses etc.

Pinja W-Oil is a water-borne fast drying wood oil which penetrates deeply into the wood. It has very good water repellent effect which reduces the cracking of the wood. It protects the surface against moisture, sunlight and dirt. Pinja W-Oil is tintable in Avatint- and Akvi Tone -tinting system. Pinja W-Oil is not suitable for floors where are hard mechanical wear resistance or strong exposure to weathering.

SURFACE PREPARATION

The surface to be treated has to be clean and dry. The moisture content of sawn

timber has to be below 20 %.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

During application and drying the temperature of the air, paint and surface should be at least +10 °C. The relative humidity should not exceed 70 %. Good ventilation is

needed during the drying process.

SYSTEM

Stir Pinja W-Oil carefully before application and thin with water if necessary. The application viscosity is 11 - 13 s (DIN4). Apply Pinja W-Oil and check that it covers all the surfaces and that the colour is even. Let the stain dry. In normal conditions with temperature of 20 - 30°C the drying time is about 1-2 hours.

Apply second coat same way as first coat.

WARRANTY OF QUALITY

Tikkurila Oyj has designed this application technology and painting system to have a maintenance interval of minimum 2-5 years if conditions of wooden construction materials are checked annually and possible damages fixed according to the maintenance instructions.

These products are tested in Tikkurila R&D laboratory and exterior test field. Long experience of the exterior use has shown that these products are suitable for painting of exterior wooden construction materials. Maintenance interval is a rough estimate, as it depends on the structural features, weather conditions, the geographic location and orientation of the objects.

MAINTENANCE

Remove dirt, mould and loose particles from the surfaces. Remove loose oil with scraper and brush the surface clean with a steel brush. Wash down dirty and mouldy surfaces with Tikkurila Mould Removal or Tehopesu Power Cleaner according to the instructions. Repaint surface according the instructions of maintenance paint. Pinia W-Oil and Valtti Akvacolor suitable products for maintenance painting. Apply evenly 1-2 coats.
